RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR EXTENSION GRANTED

On September 19, 2016, the Small Business Utility Advocates filed a motion seeking an extension of time to file comments to PacifiCorp’s 2017-2021 Renewable Portfolio Standard Implementation Plan. Comments from Staff and intervenors were due September 9, 2016. Citing various reasons, SBUA requests an extension to file comments until September 29, 2016. SBUA did not indicate whether it had conferred with other parties to seek agreement with its motion,¹ but asserts that the delay will not prejudice PacifiCorp because the utility’s response comments are not due until October 28, 2016.

No party filed an objection to the motion, and the time for doing so has passed.² The motion is granted.
