RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE*
GRANTED

On September 16, 2016, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power filed a motion to allow Erin E. Apperson to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The affidavit of Ms. Apperson accompanied the motion. Ms. Apperson states that she will associate with Sarah E. Kamman, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Erin E. Apperson as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of PacifiCorp is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
