Investigation into Schedule 37 - Avoided Cost Purchases from Qualifying Facilities of 10,000 kW or Less.

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; SCHEDULE AMENDED

On November 17, 2016, the Renewable Energy Coalition (the Coalition) and the Community Renewable Energy Association (CREA) filed a joint motion to extend the time for filing response testimony in this proceeding, currently due today, November 18, 2016, and moving up all other dates on the calendar accordingly. The parties request expedited consideration of the motion.<sup>1</sup>

The Coalition and CREA request the extension of time due to "the press of business" and to resolve ongoing discovery disputes with PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power. The two parties state that the other parties to this docket, the Oregon Solar Industries Association, Renewable Northwest, PacifiCorp, and Commission Staff either support or do not oppose the motion.
