RULING

DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE CHANGED

On June 29, 2017, I issued a ruling that suspended the procedural schedule in the above-captioned docket and directed the parties to informally address PacifiCorp's request in its motion dated June 28, 2017 or failing resolution to respond in writing by a certain date. On July 3, 2017, PacifiCorp filed a second motion to amend the procedural schedule and to withdraw the prior motion. PacifiCorp represents that the second motion is unopposed, despite the fact that some parties do not agree that there are changed circumstances or new policy considerations that require consideration.

The motion indicates that PacifiCorp, Staff, the Renewable Energy Coalition, the Community Renewable Energy Association, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, and Renewable Northwest conferred by conference call and agree to modify the following procedural dates:
