RULING

**DISPOSITION: EXPEDITED MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL
SCHEDULE GRANTED**

On August 31, 2017, a joint motion was filed by PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power, Commission Staff, the Oregon Department of Energy, the Renewable Energy Coalition, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, and the Community Renewable Energy Association. The motion indicates that each of the moving parties—the only parties having filed testimony—waives the right to cross-examine other witnesses, but reserves the right to conduct follow-up questions of its own witnesses in the event of questions by the Commission. Since the moving parties propose that there be no hearing, they ask that they not be required to submit prehearing briefs by September 5, 2017. The moving parties also ask to set due dates for opening and response briefs. The moving parties request approval on an expedited basis for a modified procedural schedule, as follows:

Given the imminent due date, I have considered the motion on expedited basis. Prehearing briefs are not due on September 5, 2017. I will consult with the Commissioners regarding whether they have any questions for the witnesses prior to cancelling the hearing. The due dates for opening and response briefs are adopted.
