On June 8, 2017, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule and stated that the parties expect to submit the stipulation and joint testimony no later than June 30, 2017 or submit a status report with respect to their progress.

On June 30, 2017, PGE filed a status report stating that the stipulating parties (PGE, PUC Staff, and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities)<sup>1</sup>, have made substantial progress in drafting a stipulation and supporting joint testimony, but they need some additional time. In its status report, PGE requests that the deadline for submission of these documents be moved to July 14, 2017.

## RULING
