DISPOSITION: PROCEDURES CLARIFIED; EXPEDITED SCHEDULE ADOPTED

The opposition to PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power's motion for a modified protective order, filed by Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition (NIPPC) after I had granted PacifiCorp's motion on an expedited basis and issued Modified Protective Order No. 18-057, shall be treated as a request for reconsideration. *See* OAR 860-001-0080(1) (Decisions by the ALJ regarding protective orders may be appealed to the Commission under OAR 860-001-0720).

Given the expedited nature of this docket, good cause exists to waive and modify certain rules governing the review of NIPPC's request for reconsideration. First, because NIPPC's response contains sufficient information to address the underlying issues, any additional filing requirements for a request for reconsideration set forth in OAR 860-001-0720 are waived. Second, I shorten the time period to respond to NIPPC's filing. Any response to the request for reconsideration shall be due by February 28, 2018.
