DISPOSITION: PETITIONS TO INTERVENE GRANTED FOR LIMITED
PURPOSES

The Commission has received petitions to intervene in this docket from the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) and the Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition (NIPPC).

This proceeding is not a contested case proceeding under ORS 183.310(2). Nonetheless, the Commission may grant petitions to intervene in non-contested cases for the limited purposes of: 1) creating a service list; and 2) establishing eligibility to sign a protective order.

The petitions to intervene filed by ICNU and NIPPC are granted for the limited purposes described above.
