DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR STAY OF TIME TO RESPOND GRANTED

On July 23, 2018, Falls Creek Hydro Limited Partnership (Falls Creek) and Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a joint motion requesting an indefinite stay for PGE to respond to the Falls Creek motion to compel. In support of the motion, the parties note that they are engaged in settlement discussions and believe that it may be possible to settle the dispute without addressing the motion. The parties reserve the right to seek a lifting of the stay, in which case they ask that PGE's response be due within fourteen days of such action by the Commission. The parties request expedited consideration.

RULING

I grant the joint motion. The time in which PGE may respond to the motion to compel is stayed. The parties shall file a status report with respect to their settlement negotiations on or before October 1, 2018.
