DISPOSITION: MOTIONS FOR EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED

On March 16, 2018, the parties filed joint motions in each of the above dockets for a two-week extension of time for Portland General Electric Company (PGE) to respond to complainants' motions for partial summary judgment. The due date would be moved from the current deadline of March 19, 2018 to a new deadline of April 2, 2018.

In support of the motions, the parties state that they are engaged in settlement discussions and believe it may be possible to settle the dispute without addressing the pending motions. The parties indicated that, in the event a settlement is not reached, they reserve the right to seek or oppose additional extensions of time.
