**RULING**

DISPOSITION: RESPONSE TO MOTIONS DUE FEBRUARY 9, 2018

On February 2, 2018, defendants filed three motions in these dockets. The first two seek either a stay of these proceedings or an extension of time to answer the complaint, until after resolution of a motion to dismiss related to the same dispute in federal court, or, alternatively, an opportunity to file a motion to dismiss in lieu of an answer.
