PREHEARING CONFERENCE
MEMORANDUM


On May 23, 2014, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon held a prehearing conference in this docket. Representatives appeared on behalf of North County Communications Corporation of Oregon, Qwest Corporation, dba CenturyLink QC, and Commission Staff.

The purpose of the conference was to address the issues raised in a supplemental status report filed by North County on May 16, 2014¹, alleging improper disconnection of service to certain of its interconnection trunks carrying traffic from CenturyLink, and requesting that the stay of proceedings presently in effect be lifted.

During a recess, the parties agreed to negotiate with each other to resolve the issues in question and to keep the Commission Staff apprised of their discussions as they impact Oregon customers. They asked that the proceedings in this case continue to be held in abeyance during this time.

No further action was requested of the Commission by either party.
