Jurisdiction

The Commission is interested in considering the extent of this Commission's jurisdiction to address call termination, in light of the nature of the call termination problem as well as activity at the federal level. Parties may comment on the question of the Commission's jurisdiction in the first round of comments or later in the proceeding.

* The schedule includes a requested date for petitions to intervene. By statute, a person may petition to intervene at any time before the close of the record.¹ However, because it is helpful if parties are identified early in the proceedings, the Commission requests that petitions to intervene be filed by the date identified above.
