On March 3, 2017, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon held a conference in this docket. Representatives appeared on behalf of Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition; the Community Energy Association; the Renewable Energy Coalition; Portland General Electric Company; Renewable Northwest and the Commission Staff.

At the conference, the parties and Staff discussed the conduct of the proceedings for the remainder of the case. The parties were ordered to jointly file no later than March 10, 2017:

- 1. A statement listing the facts and issues upon which they agree are relevant to the resolution of the proceeding; and
- 2. A statement setting forth the facts and issues of each party where those are not in agreement.

Upon review of the foregoing filing, the administrative law judge will, if necessary, conduct an additional conference with the parties, issue a ruling as to whether the statement submitted has superseded the complaint, whether a PGE answer to the complaint is required, and what the schedule shall be for the remainder of the proceedings.
