Subject: Oral Arguments Re-noticed as Executive Session

Based on advice from DOJ, the Commission is re-noticing the oral argument scheduled for tomorrow as an Executive Session under the Public Meetings Law. This is being done to reflect the fact that only those qualified under the protective order will be able to attend the arguments, which will address confidential information.

The only impact this decision has on tomorrow's event will be the requirement that I state the grounds to open an Executive Session, and to instruct any press that attends not to report any information discussed. Otherwise, the arguments will proceed as planned.
