CYPRESS CREEK RENEWABLES, LLC'S
WITHDRAWAL

On August 24, 2016, Cypress Creek Renewables, LLC (Cypress Creek) filed a Petition for Declaratory Ruling with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) alleging that PacifiCorp was obligated to offer renewable, non-standard qualifying facilities with a renewable pricing option. The Commission decided to treat Cypress Creek's Petition as a complaint. On October 21, 2016, PacifiCorp filed with the Commission answers and affirmative defenses to Cypress Creek's complaint.

On July 11, 2017, Cypress Creek and PacifiCorp entered into a Settlement Agreement and Release (Settlement Agreement) resolving all claims and counterclaims in this proceeding. Because the parties have entered into the Settlement Agreement resolving the issues between them in this docket, subject to the parties complying with all conditions of the Settlement Agreement, Cypress Creek now respectfully withdraws its complaint.
