ODOE provides program oversight along with administrative and technical services for eligible school districts in the SB1149 Schools Program, as described in ORS 757.612(3)(e).

This report summarizes the administrative expenses incurred by ODOE and billed to PGE and Pacific Power in calendar year 2012:

In Order No. 12-485 in Docket UM 1632, the Public Utility Commission acknowledged specific ODOE functions to administer the Energy Efficient Schools Program (also known as SB1149 Schools Program), including:

- Distribution calculation of PPC funds
- Maintain list of qualified energy audit and commissioning firms
- Approval of audit scopes of work
