This correspondence is in response to the notification of our requirement for the 2011 "Annual Affiliated Interest Report" for the Lakeshore Water District, Inc.

I. Organizations

The companies involved are Delta Environmental Services, Inc. (DES), Oregon Water Services, Inc. (OWS), and the Ravin Group, LLC (Ravin).

Kevin Hunt is the sole stockholder for DES. Established in 1982, the company specializes in contract operation of water and wastewater treatment facilities. It is a state certified testing laboratory that performs the laboratory work in compliance with the Oregon Health Division.

I own and operate OWS. My area of expertise is water treatment system installation, pump repair and maintenance, and wastewater system operation. I have over 25 years experience in the business.

Ravin was formed as a separate company to hold assets and provide equal ownership of interests from acquisitions. Kevin and I each hold 50% of the stock in the company.

Kevin and I own Lakeshore Water District, Inc., equally. I am acting president and Kevin is treasurer. Lakeshore Water District has the water rights and easements at the site and owns the client base that is billed for water service. Ravin owns the property, equipment and distribution system.

There are no written contracts between any of the companies involved with the system. Since Kevin and I each own 50% of the system, we take equal responsibility for its operation. This keeps the accounting system simple since we are not billing each other for services on a facility we own equally. It does, however, cause problems in notifying the PUC as to our operation costs for annual reports. Many of the costs end up being estimated according to what we charge other facilities we operate under contract. No Company had transactions of more than \$25000.
