11.2.2 General Information, Terms, and Obligations (Continued)

(F) ETS may be ordered at the customer's option on a single term commitment period of either three years or five years. The customer must notify the Company in writing of the length of its selected term commitment period. The Access Order Charge does not apply to establish a new, or make any changes to an existing, ETS Term Discount Plan.

(G) <u>Discontinuance Charges</u>

Discontinuance charges apply when the customer fails to satisfy the term commitment period and does not simultaneously replace that term plan commitment with a qualifying replacement term plan commitment. The term plan discontinuance charge is equal to 35% of the applicable undiscounted monthly rate set out in 13.2.4, below, multiplied by the number of full and partial months remaining in the existing term commitment period.

11.2.3 Service Elements

There are two rate elements; the local loop, and transport to the Pittock (T) Block located at 921 SW Washington St., Portland, OR 97205. Additional charges for construction, special equipment, or additional labor may apply. A three or five year term is required.

When the ETS is installed, the notice of installation constitutes the customer's acceptance of the Rules and Regulations set forth in this Tariff and the start of the three or five year term.
