#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

I recommend that the Commission approve reauthorization of Northwest Natural's (Northwest or company) deferrals of conservation or energy efficiency costs for a 12-month period beginning July 1, 2003.

#### DISCUSSION:

By Order No. 94-195, the Commission authorized Northwest to defer, under Schedule No. 175, revenue requirements and lost margin revenues associated with the company's Commission-approved demand-side management (DSM) programs. This authorization was for the 12 months ending January 25, 1995. Deferrals were reauthorized for the 12- month period ending November 30, 1995, by Order No. 94-1766. Subsequently, the Commission reauthorized DSM related deferrals, each year, through June 30. Current authorization extends through June 30, 2003.

Deferral of revenue requirements and lost margins associated with Northwest DSM programs is consistent with the Commission's policy to remove the significant disincentives to acquiring DSM relative to supply-side resources. ORS 757.262 allows the Commission to "...adopt policies designed to encourage the acquisition of cost-effective conservation resources." Without deferral and recovery of these direct and indirect costs of DSM, the company would again have a disincentive to acquire cost-effective conservation.

The company estimates it will defer approximately \$2,300,000 under its Schedule 175 (Conservation Resource Adjustments) and Schedule 209 (Residential High-Efficiency Furnace Program), during the 12-month period ending June 30, 2004.
