### DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On July 15, 1999, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Global NAPS Inc. (Global) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 99-420. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Global failed to comply with Commission rules and terms of the certificate, per OAR 860-032-0008(2). At the April 27, 2004, public meeting, the Commission determined that Global's certificate of authority should be canceled. Global's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 04-257.

On April 26, 2004, Global filed a request to suspend Order No. 04-257, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Global filed the requested information on April 26, 2004.

The information sent by Global to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates Global is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Global 's certificate should be rescinded.
