DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On April 2, 1996, Comdata Telecommunications Services Inc. (Comdata) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 96 084.

In a letter dated June 28, 2004, Comdata Telecommunications Services Inc. (through its Vice President, Lisa Peerman) requested that its authority be cancelled. The letter notes that Comdata no longer has customers in Oregon and it does not intend to market telecommunications services in Oregon. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority in Oregon for one or more days during 2004, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Comdata Telecommunications Services Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Comdata Telecommunications Services Inc. is cancelled.
