DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On April 12, 2001, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to the City of Ashland/Ashland Fiber Network (Ashland) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 01-280. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to pay annual revenue fees to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Ashland failed to pay the late statement penalty fee as required in OAR 860-032-0095(2)(b). On April 19, May 14, and June 15, 2004, the Commission notified the certificate holder that the required fee was not received. At the July 20, 2004, public meeting, the Commission determined that Ashland's certificate of authority should be canceled. Ashland's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 04-425.

On September 7, 2004, Ashland filed a request to suspend Order No. 04-425, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Ashland paid the requested fee on August 30, 2004.

The fee sent by Ashland to the Commission was late. However, the fee has been received and indicates Ashland is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Ashland's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 04-425 canceling the certificate of authority of the City of Ashland/Ashland Fiber Network., is rescinded.
