DISPOSITION: APPLICATION APPROVED

On January 5, 2005, Sno Cap Water System (Sno Cap) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) to waive the \$100 late statement fee (late fee). Pursuant to ORS 756.310, each utility is required to pay the Commission an annual fee. Payment is due on April 1 of each year. If the utility does not pay by 5:00 p.m. on the fifth business day following the due date, a late fee of \$100 is assessed. Pursuant to OAR 860-036-0001(1), the Commission may relieve any obligations under Division 36 rules and, due to the late timing of Sno Cap receiving its statement, the application for waiver of the late fee should be approved. A description of the filing is contained in the Staff Report, attached as Appendix A, and incorporated by reference.

At its Public Meeting on February 8, 2005, the Commission adopted Staff's Recommendation and approved Sno Cap's application for waiver of its late fee.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Sno Cap Water System's application to waive the \$100 late statement fee assessed on its gross revenue fee due April 1, 2004, is granted.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Pursuant to ORS 756.310, OAR 860-036-0095(3)(c), and OAR 860-036-0001(1), Staff recommends that Sno Cap Water System's (Sno Cap or the Company) application to waive the \$100 late statement fee (late fee) assessed on its gross revenue fee (annual fee) be approved.

DISCUSSION:

Sno Cap is a public water utility and, as such, is subject to ORS 756.310 that requires each public utility to pay the Commission an annual fee. Annual fee statements (statement) are mailed to each public utility on March 5th every year. Payment of the annual fee to the Commission is due on April 1 each year. The fee is considered late if it is not received by 5:00 p.m. on the fifth business day following the due date [OAR 60-036-0095] and is assessed a late fee of \$100 [OAR 860-036-0095(3)(c)].

The Company requests that the \$100 late fee be waived. Sno Cap sent a letter dated January 5, 2005, to PUC along with its \$35.35 annual fee payment for the year 2003. The Company states that PUC sent the invoice to Bill Wolfe, Sno Cap Water System, PO Box 215, Sisters, Oregon. Mr. Wolfe is no longer associated with the Company. According to Sno Cap, it received PUC's gross revenue statement for 2003 on December 19, 2004.

Pursuant to OAR 860-036-0001(1):

... Upon application by a water utility, the Commission may relieve it of any obligations under these rules.

Since the Company received its statement at such a late date, Staff recommends that the Commission relieve Sno Cap of its obligation to pay the \$100 late fee pursuant to OAR 860-036-0001(1).
