DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On October 25, 2001, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Northwest Open Access Network Oregon (NoaNet) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 01-897. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that NoaNet failed to file an annual report for the year 2004 as required by OAR 860-032-0060(2)(a). The Commission notified NoaNet twice that the report had not been received. At the August 2, 2005, public meeting, the Commission determined that NoaNet's certificate of authority should be canceled. NoaNet's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 05-956.

On September 2, 2005, NoaNet filed a request to suspend Order No. 05-956, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that NoaNet filed the requested information.

The information sent by NoaNet to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates NoaNet is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of NoaNet's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 05-956 canceling the certificate of authority of Northwest Open Access Network Oregon is rescinded.
