DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On December 13, 2002, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Transcom Communications Inc. (Transcom) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 02-876. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to pay annual revenue fees to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Transcom failed to pay the revenue fees as required in ORS 756.310. On April 28, 2005, the Commission notified the certificate holder that the required fees were not received. At the August 2, 2005, public meeting, the Commission determined that Transcom's certificate of authority should be canceled. Transcom's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 05-942.

On September 19, 2005, Transcom filed a request to suspend Order No. 05-942, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Transcom paid the requested fees.

The fees sent by Transcom to the Commission were late. However, the fees have been received and indicate Transcom is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Transcom's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 05-942 canceling the certificate of authority of Transcom Communications Inc. is rescinded.
