DISPOSITION: COMPLAINT DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE

On April 29, 2005, Preheim Computers (Complainant) filed a complaint against CenturyTel of Oregon, Inc. (CenturyTel), alleging that that it had been inappropriately billed for service. On August 2, 2005, a hearing was held in Scappoose, Oregon. After the hearing, the parties reached an agreement that resolved all issues. The presiding Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) agreed to suspend further proceedings and keep the docket open until the provisions of the agreement were fulfilled.

On October 11, 2005, CenturyTel filed a letter stating that Complainant's account had been credited pursuant to the terms of the settlement. On October 13, 2005, the presiding ALJ sent a letter to Complainant, stating that the complaint would be dismissed unless Complainant explained why the terms of the settlement had not been fulfilled. Complainant was given until October 24, 2005, to respond. No response was filed.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint filed by Preheim Computers against CenturyTel of Oregon, Inc., is dismissed with prejudice.
