## DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On December 11, 2002, Comm South Companies Inc. (Comm South) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 02-865.

Pursuant to a letter dated December 1, 2005, Sheri Pringle, Director of Regulatory Affairs, requested that the certificate of authority for Comm South be cancelled. Comm South is in Chapter 7 bankruptcy protection and is in the process of liquidating its business and its assets, including discontinuing telecommunications service. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority in 2005, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year. The Oregon Public Utility Commission will file a proof of claim with the Bankruptcy Court of the Northern District of Texas.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Comm South Companies Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Comm South Companies Inc. is cancelled.
