## DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On October 9, 1996, Transcommunications Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 96-269.

In a letter dated March 14, 2005, Andrew Isar, Regulatory Consultant to Transcommunications Inc., informed the Commission of the company's intent to discontinue provision of discretionary prepaid, interexchange telecommunications service in Oregon effective May 1, 2005. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2004, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Transcommunications Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Transcommunications Inc. is cancelled.
