DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On August 17, 2001, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to BendTel Inc. (BendTel) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 01-737. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that BendTel failed to respond to the Commission's original, and second, request to file an annual report for the year 2004, as required by OAR 860-032-0060(2)(a). At the August 2, 2005, public meeting, the Commission determined that BendTel's certificate of authority should be canceled. BendTel's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 05-909.

On August 24, 2005, BendTel filed a request to suspend Order No. 05-909, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that BendTel filed the requested information.

The information sent by BendTel to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates BendTel is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of BendTel's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 05-909 canceling the certificate of authority of BendTel Inc., is rescinded.
