### STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the Commission allow the extension of the pool participation notice requirements from March 1 to June 1 for the 2006 rate year only.

Access Plan (OCAP) until June 1, 2006.

### **DISCUSSION:**

On February 1, 2006, the Oregon Exchange Carrier Association (OECA) filed a request to extend the pool participation notice requirement contained in part VII of the Oregon Customer Access Plan (OCAP) from March 1 to June 1, 2006.

The Commission, in docket UM 384, issued Order 93-1133 which adopted the 1994 OCAP. Subsequently, the Commission issued Order 03-294 adopting an amended OCAP as directed by Order 03-082 in docket UM 1017. Part VII of the OCAP states, in part, that participation in the OECA pools shall be optional for Incumbent Local Exchange Carriers (ILECs) on a year to year basis. Any ILEC deciding not to participate for a future rate year shall notify the OPUC and OECA in writing of its decision by March 1 of the rate year in question.

Order 03-082 adopted a stipulation detailing how the OUSF would expand to include support distributions to the rural ILECs. Among the various items, the stipulation includes directions on the cost model, the calculation of the support per line and the

revenue offsets to ensure revenue neutrality. The primary offset is used to reduce state charges, specifically the Carrier Common Line (CCL).<sup>2</sup> The order also includes a 3-year review of costs. The expansion of the OUS Fund to include support disbursements to rural ILECs was implemented in November 2003. Staff is performing the 3-year review and plans a March 8, 2006 workshop to discuss the findings with the rural ILECs. As OECA states in its request, the companies would like to retain their options related to pool participation until the final OUSF support per line amounts are known.

Staff and OECA acknowledge that the final support amounts may not be known in time for the July 1, 2006, access charge implementation date.<sup>3</sup> In that case, OECA will use current support per line amounts as an offset to the CCL revenue requirement. When new support amounts are finalized, OECA can make a subsequent filing.

Staff has no objection to the three month extension. The extension applies to this rate year only, the extension will not affect the OCAP-prescribed filing date of the annual access charge tariff changes of March 15, 2006, as called for in the plan, and it will not affect the July 1 effective date of the filing.

## PROPOSED COMMISSION MOTION:

The extension of the pool participation notice requirement from March 1 to June 1 for the 2006 rate year be approved.
