In a letter received May 8, 2006, Lori Blakely informed the Commission that American Long Lines Inc. has merged into PAETEC Communications Inc. and AMLL's operations in Oregon are discontinued. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority in Oregon during 2006, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by American Long Lines Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by American Long Lines Inc. is cancelled.
