DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED IN PART

On September 22, 2004, Sterling Communications Inc. (Sterling) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 04-557.

In a letter dated April 13, 2006, Dorothy Young, of CHR Solutions, authorized representative of Sterling, requested that the certificate of authority for Sterling be amended to reflect that Sterling will only be a provider of statewide interexchange services. Sterling will no longer be providing statewide local services.

In view of the foregoing, Sterling's certificate of authority to provide intraexchange (local exchange) switched service (i.e., local dial tone) and non-switched private line service (dedicated transmission service) within all exchanges of the telecommunications utilities and cooperative corporations listed in Appendices A and B to Order No. 04-557 should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority to provide local dial tone and local private line service held by Sterling Communications Inc. is cancelled.
