On May 13, 2002, Infone LLC was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 02-332.

In a letter dated January 18, 2007, Robin Norton, Consultant for Infone LLC, informed the Commission that Infone LLC has ceased all operations in Oregon since December 2005 and its certificate of authority should be withdrawn. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2007, it is required to file a GRT form and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Infone LLC should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Infone LLC is cancelled.
