DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On September 27, 2000, Central Utah Communications Inc.(Central Utah) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 00-595.

In a letter received on February 16, 2007, Dale Lewis, President of Central Utah, informed the Commission that the company had ceased operations as of July 31, 2006. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2007, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Central Utah Communications Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Central Utah Communications Inc. is cancelled.

A party may request rehearing or reconsideration of this order pursuant to ORS 756.561. A request for rehearing or reconsideration must be filed with the Commission within 60 days of the date of service of this order. The request must comply with the requirements in OAR 860-014-0095. A copy of any such request must also be served on each party to the proceeding as provided by OAR 860-013-0070(2). A party may appeal this order by filing a petition for review with the Court of Appeals in compliance with ORS 183.480-183.484.
