In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Justin Beckham d/b/a Velocity Internet should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Justin Beckham d/b/a Velocity Internet is cancelled.
