On March 18, 2003, Consolidated Communications Operator Services Inc. (Consolidated) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 03-162.

In a letter dated September 21, 2007, Scott Kitchen, Sr. Manager, Regulatory Compliance for Consolidated, informed the Commission that the company does not have any customers in Oregon, and its certificate of authority should be cancelled. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for more than one day in 2007, it is required to file an annual fee statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Consolidated Communications Operator Services Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Consolidated Communications Operator Services Inc. is cancelled.
