DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On June 12, 2003, US LEC Communications Inc. (US LEC) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 03-366.

In a letter dated November 12, 2007, Grace R. Chiu, Counsel to US LEC, informed the Commission that US LEC no longer has any customers in the State of Oregon and, therefore, requested that the company be removed from the Commission's list of telecommunications providers certified to do business in Oregon. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority in Oregon for one or more days in 2007, it is required to file an annual fee statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by US LEC Communications Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by US LEC Communications Inc. is cancelled.
