On April 27, 2007, Comspan Communications, fka Wantel Inc., (Comspan)<sup>1</sup>, filed its Application for Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) in the Myrtle Point Wire Center pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996. The Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) docketed the application as UM 1312.

On May 15, 2007, Comspan amended its request with a new application seeking ETC status for the Oakridge, Veneta, Reedsport, and Myrtle Point wire centers. This second request was docketed as UM 1316. In its second application, Comspan requested that the UM 1312 application be superseded and withdrawn. Subsequently, on February 7, 2008, Comspan filed a formal motion to withdraw the UM 1312 application and to close the docket.

## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the motion to withdraw the application filed by Comspan Communications is granted. Docket UM 1312 is closed.
