DISPOSITION: DOCKET CLOSED

On August 28, 2006, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed an Application to Defer Certain Expenses Associated with the Bonneville Power Administration's Conservation Rate Credit with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Docket UM 1277), and received approval through Order No. 06-584. PGE's application requested approval to defer costs associated with the Bonneville Power Administration Residential Exchange Program (REP) that provided PGE with rate credits for conservation and renewable resource development, known as the Conservation and Renewable Discount – (C&RD), later known as the Conservation and Renewables Credit (CRC).

On October 1, 2007, PGE filed for reauthorization of this deferral (Docket UM 1277(1)). PGE discussed this docket with Staff on March 3, 2008, and agrees that this application can be withdrawn since there is no current activity and no activity is expected until the resumption of the REP. PGE will file an application for deferred accounting when activity related to the CRC is imminent. Therefore, PGE withdraws its application for reauthorization in UM 1277(1), and requests that the docket be closed.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Docket UM 1277(1) is closed.
