DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On March 2, 1993, Metro One Telecommunications Inc. (Metro One) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 93-272.

In a letter dated March 31, 2008, Laurie Willman, Assistant Vice President of Corporate Development for Metro One, informed the Commission that Metro One is not providing service under its certification and its certificate of authority should be cancelled. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2008, it is required to file a revenue fee statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Metro One Telecommunications Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Metro One Telecommunications Inc. is cancelled.
