DISPOSITION: CHARGES ASSESSED

The Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) has designated its files on the subject of this matter as the record in this case. Based on information contained in those files, the Commission makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

PHONETEC PCS LLC is a telecommunications provider required to submit quarterly contribution worksheets and payments to the Commission for the Oregon Universal Service Fund (OUSF). *See* ORS 759.425, and OAR 860-032-0620.

PHONETEC PCS LLC failed to submit the quarterly contribution worksheet(s) and payment(s) by the due date(s) as set out in OAR 860-032-0620(3).

The Commission sent a Proposed Order to PHONETEC PCS LLC on March 31, 2008. PHONETEC PCS LLC did not respond.

Pursuant to OAR 860-032-0620 and OAR 860-032-0630, the Commission has proposed PHONETEC PCS LLC owes the \$100 late statement fee for the third quarter of 2007.



The amount set forth above should be assessed, with the exception that the interest, where applicable, will continue to accrue at 9 percent per annum until the Commission receives full contribution payment.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the above amounts are assessed against PHONETEC PCS LLC and are immediately due and payable to the Public Utility Commission, PO Box 2153, Salem, Oregon 97308-2153.



A party may request rehearing or reconsideration of this order pursuant to ORS 756.561. A request for rehearing or reconsideration must be filed with the Commission within 60 days of the date of service of this order. The request must comply with the requirements in OAR 860-014-0095. A copy of any such request must also be served on each party to the proceeding as provided by OAR 860-013-0070(2). A party may appeal this order by filing a petition for review with the Court of Appeals in compliance with ORS 183.480-183.484.
