The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2008, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by InteraTel LLC should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by InteraTel LLC is cancelled.
