## DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On March 6, 2002, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to City of Sandy Oregon (City of Sandy) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 02-143. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to pay annual revenue fees to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that City of Sandy failed to pay the revenue fees as required in ORS 756.310. On April 14, 2008, the Commission notified the certificate holder that the required fees were not received. At the May 6, 2008, public meeting, the Commission determined that City of Sandy's certificate of authority should be canceled. City of Sandy's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 08-282.

On June 30, 2008, City of Sandy filed a request to suspend Order No. 08-282, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that City of Sandy paid the requested fees.

The fees sent by City of Sandy to the Commission were late. However, the fees have been received and indicate City of Sandy is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of City of Sandy's certificate should be rescinded.

## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 08-282 canceling the certificate of authority of City of Sandy Oregon, is rescinded.
