## DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On August 2, 2007, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to North County Communications Corporation of Oregon (North County) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 07-331. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to pay annual revenue fees to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that North County failed to submit the annual fee statement and payment by the due date of April 1, 2008. *See* OAR 860-032-0095. North County filed an annual fee statement and payment on April 21, 2008, but failed to submit the late payment penalty of 2 percent and \$100 late statement penalty as required by ORS 756.310. On April 21, 2008, the Commission notified the certificate holder that the required fees were not received. At the May 6, 2008, public meeting, the Commission determined that North County's certificate of authority should be canceled. North County's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 08-272.

On July 19, 2008, North County filed a request to suspend Order No. 08-272, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that North County paid the requested fees.

The fees sent by North County to the Commission were late. However, the fees have been received and indicate North County is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of North County's certificate should be rescinded.

## **ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 08-272 canceling the certificate of authority of North County Communications Corporation of Oregon, is rescinded.

A party may request rehearing or reconsideration of this order pursuant to ORS 756.561. A request for rehearing or reconsideration must be filed with the Commission within 60 days of the date of service of this order. The request must comply with the requirements in OAR 860-014-0095. A copy of any such request must also be served on each party to the proceeding as provided by OAR 860-013-0070(2). A party may appeal this order by filing a petition for review with the Court of Appeals in compliance with ORS 183.480-183.484.
