DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On September 2, 2008, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to TeleQuality Communications Inc. (TeleQuality) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 08-444. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that TeleQuality failed to comply with Oregon Universal Service Fund requirements per ORS 759.425. At the December 23, 2008, public meeting, the Commission determined that TeleQuality's certificate of authority should be canceled. TeleQuality's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 08-612.

On January 20, 2009, TeleQuality filed a request to suspend Order No. 08-612, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that TeleQuality filed the requested information.

The information sent by TeleQuality to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates TeleQuality is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of TeleQuality's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 08-612 canceling the certificate of authority of TeleQuality Communications Inc. is rescinded.
