DISPOSITION: CHARGES ASSESSED

The Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) has designated its files on the subject of this matter as the record in this case. Based on information contained in those files, the Commission makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

WTI LLC is a telecommunications provider required to submit quarterly contribution worksheets and payments to the Commission for the Oregon Universal Service Fund (OUSF). *See* ORS 759.425, and OAR 860-032-0620.

WTI LLC failed to meet all or part of the requirements specified above by the due date(s) as set out in OAR 860-032-0620(3).

The Commission sent a Proposed Order to WTI LLC on July 6, 2009. WTI LLC did not respond.

Pursuant to OAR 860-032-0620 and OAR 860-032-0630, the Commission has proposed WTI LLC owes \$100.00 which can include any or all of the following: contribution payment(s), late payment penalty(ies), interest and late statement fee(s), including any portion due but not paid for the period(s). These charges are for the 4th quarter 2008.

Where applicable, the interest amount is calculated as of the date of this order. The interest will continue to accrue at 9 percent per annum until the Commission receives full contribution payment. *See* OAR 860-032-0620(7). 
Conclusions

WTI LLC failed to meet its filing obligations required by law. The amount set forth above should be assessed, with the exception that any applicable interest will continue to accrue at 9 percent per annum until the Commission receives full contribution payment.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The above amounts are assessed against WTI LLC and are immediately due and payable to the Public Utility Commission, PO Box 2153, Salem, Oregon 97308-2153.
- 2. Where applicable, interest will continue to accrue at 9 percent per annum until the Commission receives full contribution payment.



A party may request rehearing or reconsideration of this order pursuant to ORS 756.561. A request for rehearing or reconsideration must be filed with the Commission within 60 days of the date of service of this order. The request must comply with the requirements in OAR 860-014-0095. A copy of any such request must also be served on each party to the proceeding as provided by OAR 860-013-0070(2). A party may appeal this order by filing a petition for review with the Court of Appeals in compliance with ORS 183.480-183.484.
