## DISPOSITION: COMPLAINT DISMISSED; DOCKET CLOSED

On June 22, 2009, Adaptive Development LLC (Complainant) filed a formal consumer complaint (Complaint) against PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power (Defendant). The Complaint related to the negotiation of a contract for the installation of a line extension and the delivery of new electric service by Defendant at Complainant's new multi-tenant commercial site (Site) in Portland, Oregon. The "start date" for charging the Contract Minimum Billing charge was primarily at issue.

A telephone prehearing conference was held in the matter on August 10, 2009. At the close of the conference, the parties were directed to continue discussing contractual terms. A second telephone conference was scheduled for August 24, 2009.

On August 24, 2009, the parties filed a Joint Motion to Dismiss. The parties indicate that they executed a contract for installation of the line extension and delivery of new electric service at the Site. They indicate that all issues have been resolved in a mutually satisfactory manner, and ask that the proceeding be dismissed.

## **ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that the Joint Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED. This docket is closed.
