## DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On September 15, 2004, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Advanced Tel Inc, (ATI) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 04-531.

Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that ATI failed to file an annual report for the year 2004 as required by OAR 860-032-0060(2)(a). At the August 2, 2005, public meeting, the Commission determined that ATI's certificate of authority should be canceled. ATI's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 05-905. On August 18, 2005, ATI filed a request to suspend Order No. 05-905, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that ATI filed the requested information and Order No. 05-967 was entered on August 30, 2005, reinstating ATI's certificate of authority.

Again, after investigation, the Commission found that ATI failed to file the minimum \$100 revenue fee and associated late payment penalties for 2008 as required by ORS 756.310. ATI also failed to file the 2008 annual report as required by OAR 860-032-0060(2)(a). At the June 16, 2009, public meeting, the Commission determined that ATI's certificate of authority should be canceled. ATI's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 09-243. On September 18, 2009, ATI filed a request to suspend Order No. 09-243, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that ATI filed the requested information.

The information sent by ATI to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates ATI is providing telecommunications

service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of ATI's certificate should be rescinded.

The Commission notes that this is the second time that ATI has sought reinstatement following the cancellation of its authority. Under these circumstances, the Commission emphasizes the need for ATI to fully comply with the Commission's rules and regulations in the future. If ATI again fails to fulfill its regulatory obligations, the Commission may conclude that it is not in the public interest to process a future application for re-certification as a competitive provider.

## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 09-243 canceling the certificate of authority of Advanced Tel Inc., is rescinded.
