ORDER

DISPOSITION: PARTIAL STIPULATION ADOPTED; ORDER  
NO. 06-292 AMENDED TO CHANGE 2013  
ANNUAL REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

**I. SUMMARY**

In this order, we adopt a partial stipulation of the parties regarding the annual reporting requirements in 2013 for recertification of telecommunications carriers eligible to receive federal Universal Service Fund (USF) support. We also amend our Order No. 06-292 by adding additional provisions to the ordering clauses which, for the year 2013, provide that carriers may submit certain reports filed with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) in lieu of the annual reporting requirement specified in that order.

**II. INTRODUCTION**

The Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act) has, among its goals, the promotion of quality services at just, reasonable, and affordable rates, access to advanced telecommunications and information services, and access to services in rural areas comparable to services in urban areas. Integral to the Act is a national policy that every household have, at a minimum, the equivalent of single-line, basic voice-grade, telephone service, often referred to as "Lifeline" service. To that end, it provides for the USF which provides financial support to designated providers of telecommunications services in high-cost areas and to qualifying low-income consumers. A carrier that meets the standards necessary to receive federal USF support is designated an eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC).

Section 214(e) of the Act sets forth the requirements for ETC designation. Under federal law, states can also set standards for granting a carrier ETC status, and Oregon has done so. In Order No. 06-292<sup>1</sup>, we established guidelines for carriers seeking certification as ETCs in Oregon. An itemized “checklist” was attached to the order as Appendix A. The checklist consists of two parts: the “Initial Designation—Application Requirements” and the “Annual Recertification Requirements.”

Under the Annual Recertification Requirements, we currently require Oregon ETCs to file Oregon-specific annual reports by July 15 of each year. These reports were designed to provide sufficient information to enable the Commission to recertify Oregon ETCs to the FCC by October 1 of each year.

### III. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Late in 2011, the FCC issued an order transforming the FUSF and changing the types of high-cost support available to ETCs (*USF/ICC Transformation Order*). The *Order* significantly increased the FCC's role in the ETC designation and recertification process, and implemented new mandatory annual reporting requirements for ETCs receiving FUSF high-cost support. In addition, early in 2012, the FCC issued a separate order reforming its Lifeline program for low-income support and implementing new requirements for ETCs that provide Lifeline services (*Lifeline Reform Order*). The *Lifeline Reform Order* requires ETCs receiving Lifeline support to submit new annual reports to the FCC. The result of these two FCC orders is that the FCC now requires all ETCs to submit new annual reports directly to them, at a date still to be determined. The ETCs must also share copies of these reports with the relevant state commissions.

Given the due dates for the reports and the commonalities in information contained in both the Oregon and FCC reports, on March 7, 2013, we opened this docket to review our existing ETC requirements to harmonize as necessary the Commission requirements with the new FCC mandatory requirements and modifications to the FUSF program. The review would address the two types of requirements—initial ETC designation requirements and annual reporting requirements—separately and in phases, for reasons of urgency and complexity. We realized that it might well be that the annual reports required by Order No. 06-292 can be replaced by the FCC reports, thereby eliminating duplication and lessening the regulatory burdens placed on Oregon ETCs.

We concluded that the first phase of this docket should address these annual reporting requirements. The objective of the first phase of the docket would be to determine whether the new FCC reports contain information sufficient to meet the Commission's needs for annual ETC recertifications for this, and following, years. If that were the case, the Commission reports could be replaced by the FCC reports, thereby eliminating duplication and lessening the regulatory burdens placed on Oregon ETCs. A prehearing conference establishing a schedule for this phase was held on March 22, 2013, and numerous entities intervened and became parties in the proceeding. A partial stipulation and motion to amend order, discussed below, was filed June 3, 2013 on behalf of all of the parties.

By letter of June 13, 2013, the Commission Staff advised the Commission that on June 10, 2013, the FCC had granted a limited waiver of certain ETC annual reporting requirements until after the Federal Office of Management and Budget approves the FCC's new annual report form. The FCC order also granted a limited waiver of the states' usual October 1 deadline for filing annual certification.<sup>2</sup>

#### IV. PARTIAL STIPULATION AND MOTION TO AMEND ORDER

A partial stipulation between AT&T Corp., Teleport Communications America LLC, and AT&T Mobility LLC; Boomerang Wireless, LLC; Budget Prepay, Inc.; Commission Staff; CenturyTel of Oregon, Inc., CenturyTel of Eastern Oregon, Inc., United Telephone Company of the Northwest d/b/a CenturyLink, and Qwest Corporation; the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon; Cricket Communications, Inc.; Frontier Communications Northwest, Inc., Citizens Telecommunications Co. of Oregon; Nexus Communications Inc.; Oregon Telecommunications Association; T-Mobile West LLC; United States Cellular Corp.; Warm Springs Telecommunications Company; and YourTel America, Inc., was filed with the Commission on June 3, 2013. It is attached to this order as Appendix A.

The stipulation proposes that, in lieu of filing the annual Oregon reports for ETC recertification normally due on July 15, 2013, eligible telecommunications carriers could submit copies of their mandatory 2013 FCC reports within fourteen (14) days after the FCC 2013 submission deadlines, with subsequent reports or revisions filed no later than 5 days after being submitted to the FCC. Furthermore, no later than July 15, 2013, a notarized affidavit from an officer of the ETC must be submitted to the Commission certifying that all federal high-cost support received within Oregon was used in the preceding calendar year and will be used in the coming calendar year only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrade of facilities and services for which the support was intended. Competitive ETCs receiving high-cost support will file network improvement plans by July 15, as required by Order No. 06-292.

The partial stipulation is limited only to amending Order No. 06-292 and does not relieve the carriers of any other obligations or requirements and does not preclude the Commission from changing requirements for any carrier in any future order, or prevent the Commission staff from seeking clarifications or additional information relating to the recertification process.

The parties also agreed that carriers may claim confidentiality for documents submitted and that they will revisit in this docket the general issue of annual reports for ETC recertification after October 1, 2013, to determine if the recertification reporting process should be modified in future years.

Accompanying the stipulation was a motion filed to amend Order No. 06-292 on an expedited basis and to waive the requirements of OAR 860-001-0350(7)(a). The amendment to that order is necessary in order to add the alternative reporting provisions contained in the stipulation to the ordering clauses. Expedited consideration and waiver

are requested because the due date for the submission of the annual recertification reports is less than six weeks from the date of the filing of the stipulation. Unless waived by the Commission or the presiding Administrative Law Judge, OAR 860-001-0350(7)(a) provides that written testimony or an explanatory brief must accompany a stipulation in support thereof. Staff represents that all parties have been consulted and support the motion. Staff further states in its June 13, 2013 letter, that neither the stipulation, the motion to amend Order 06-292, nor their approval by the Commission, will be materially affected by the FCC's June 10, 2013 order.

## V. DISCUSSION

In opening this docket it was our hope that Staff would work with the affected ETCs and interested parties to quickly recommend a course of action to determine if there was a means to replace the Commission reports with FCC reports and still provide us with all of the information necessary to enable industry oversight in the public interest. We find that the interim step to be applied to the July 15, 2013 reports, as proposed by the parties in their partial stipulation, provides the Commission with the opportunity to assess the impact of such a transition, while reducing the regulatory burden upon such carriers and allowing the parties to continue to explore the ramifications of such changes in this phase of the proceeding. We also conclude that the requested order amendments in the stipulation are reasonable and necessary to effectuate the stipulation. The partial stipulation should be adopted.

## VI. ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The partial stipulation between AT&T Corp., Teleport Communications America LLC, and AT&T Mobility LLC; Boomerang Wireless, LLC; Budget Prepay, Inc.; Commission Staff; CenturyTel of Oregon, Inc., CenturyTel of Eastern Oregon, Inc., United Telephone Company of the Northwest d/b/a CenturyLink, and Qwest Corporation; the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon; Cricket Communications, Inc.; Frontier Communications Northwest, Inc., Citizens Telecommunications Co. of Oregon; Nexus Communications Inc.; Oregon Telecommunications Association; T-Mobile West LLC; United States Cellular Corp.; Warm Springs Telecommunications Company; and YourTel America, Inc., attached as Appendix A, is adopted;
2. Order No. 06-292 is amended by adding the following to the ordering clauses:
  5. Other than the filing of a network improvement plan update as required in this order for competitive carriers, eligible telecommunications carriers shall not be required to file the annual set of Oregon carrier reports for ETC recertification that would be due by July 15, 2013. In lieu of filing the 2013 reports, each carrier shall comply with the following:

a. Each carrier shall file with the Commission a copy of each report pertaining to Oregon that the ETC files with the FCC for 2013, pursuant to the following regulations, as applicable:

- A. 47 CFR § 54.304 (CAF ICC support);
- B. 47 CFR § 54.313 (high-cost support);
- C. 47 CFR § 54.422 (low-income support); and
- D. 47 CFR § 54.1009 (mobility fund support).

b. Copies of the foregoing 2013 FCC reports shall be filed with Commission no later than fourteen (14) days after each report is due to be submitted to the FCC. Subsequent updates or revisions to such reports shall be filed no later than five business days following the date any update or revision is submitted to the FCC.

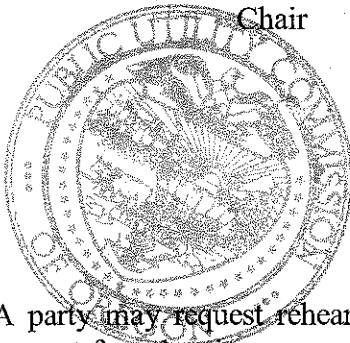
c. Each carrier receiving federal high-cost support shall, no later than July 15, 2013, file a notarized affidavit from an officer of the carrier company in the form approved by Commission Staff certifying that all federal high-cost support received within Oregon was used in the preceding calendar year, and will be used in the coming calendar year only for the provision, maintenance and upgrade of facilities and services for which the support is intended.


3. The remainder of Order No. 06-292 is unchanged.

## PARTIAL STIPULATION

## INTRODUCTION

1. The parties to this Stipulation are AT&T Corp., Teleport Communications America LLC, AT&T Mobility LLC ( collectively "AT&T"), Boomerang Wireless, LLC, Budget Prepay, Inc., staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon ("Staff"), CenturyTel of Oregon, Inc., CenturyTel of Eastern Oregon, Inc., United Telephone Company of the Northwest d/b/a CenturyLink, and Qwest Corporation (collectively "CenturyLink"), the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon ("CUB"), Cricket Communications, Inc., Frontier Communications Northwest Inc. and Citizen's Telecommunications Co. of Oregon (dba Frontier Communications of Oregon), Nexus Communications Inc., Oregon Telecommunications Association ("OTA"), T-Mobile West LLC ("T-Mobile"), United States Cellular Corp. ("US Cellular"), Warm Springs Telecommunications Company, and YourTel America Inc., collectively referred to as "the Parties." The Parties are the only parties to the above-captioned docket.<sup>1</sup>

2. By entering into this Partial Stipulation, the Parties intend to resolve the pending issue of the annual reporting requirements in 2013 for recertification of telecommunications carriers eligible to receive federal Universal Service Fund

1 support and establish a time to reconsider annual reporting requirements for future  
2 reporting years.

### 3 BACKGROUND

4 3. In Order No. 06-292, the Commission adopted requirements for the annual  
5 recertification of telecommunications carriers eligible to receive federal Universal  
6 Service Fund ("FUSF") support from the Federal Communications Commission  
7 ("FCC"), commonly referred to as Eligible Telecommunications Carriers ("ETCs").

8 4. The Commission currently requires Oregon ETCs to file the Oregon-specific annual  
9 reports listed in Appendix A of Order 06-292 by July 15 of each year. The  
10 Commission established these annual reports to gain sufficient information to enable  
11 it to re-certify Oregon ETCs to the FCC by October 1 of each year as required by 47  
12 CFR § 54.314, and to monitor ETCs' ongoing compliance with requirements. These  
13 requirements were established based on prior FCC decisions and the testimony and  
14 comments submitted in Docket No. UM 1217.

15 5. In November 2011, the FCC issued an order that, in relevant part, provides for new  
16 mandatory annual reporting requirements for ETCs receiving high-cost support.  
17 Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, FCC 11-161  
18 (November 18, 2011). In February 2012, the FCC issued an order that includes new  
19 annual reporting requirements for ETCs receiving support from the federal Lifeline  
20 program for low-income support. Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed  
21 Rulemaking, FCC 12-11 (February 6, 2012). FCC annual reporting procedures are  
22 developing. High-cost annual reporting requirements are currently largely reflected  
23 in FCC regulations, specifically 47 CFR § 54.313. Reporting requirements for ETCs  
24 receiving Lifeline support are reflected in 47 CFR § 54.422. In addition, annual  
25 reporting requirements for ETCs receiving Connect America Fund ("CAF ICC")  
26 support are provided in 47 CFR § 54.304 and annual reporting requirements for ETCs

1 receiving Mobility Fund support are set forth in 47 CFR § 54.1009. These annual

2 reports are due to the FCC by July 1 of each calendar year.<sup>2</sup>

3 6. The FCC annual reports cover many of the same items that are included in the  
4 Oregon reports. The FCC requires ETCs to submit copies of their FCC reports to  
5 state commissions. The new FCC reports may result in duplication of reporting for  
6 ETCs and increased burdens on ETCs that can be reduced if the Oregon reporting  
7 requirements are modified for 2013.

8 7. The Commission opened this Docket to review and consider changes to the  
9 requirements for designation and annual recertification of ETCs. The Docket  
10 addresses these issues in two phases, with Phase I designated to address ETC annual  
11 reporting requirements and Phase II to address initial requirements of ETC  
12 designation.

13 8. In Phase I, the Parties participated in a workshop on April 15, 2013. ETCs must  
14 submit their new annual FCC reports to the FCC by July 1 of this year. Due to the  
15 time constraints presented by this deadline, the Parties agreed to first address the issue  
16 of 2013 reporting requirements, as reflected in this Partial Stipulation.

17 9. By amending the reporting requirements in Order 06-292 for the 2013 reporting year,  
18 the Parties may better assess the necessity of any longer-term amendments. The issue  
19 of the annual reports for ETC recertification in 2014 and subsequent years can be  
20 evaluated in light of the 2013 recertification process after October 1, 2013.

#### 21 PARTIAL STIPULATION

22 1. The Parties agree to request that the Commission amend Order 06-292 to add the  
23 following provisions to page 18 of the Order:

1 5. Other than the filing of a network improvement plan update as  
2 required in this order for competitive carriers, eligible telecommunications  
3 carriers shall not be required to file the annual set of Oregon carrier  
reports for ETC recertification that would be due by July 15, 2013. In lieu  
of filing the 2013 reports, each carrier shall comply with the following:

4 a. Each carrier shall file with the Commission a copy of each report  
5 pertaining to Oregon that the ETC files with the FCC for 2013, pursuant to  
the following regulations, as applicable:

- 6 A. 47 CFR § 54.304 (CAF ICC support);  
7 B. 47 CFR § 54.313 (high-cost support);  
8 C. 47 CFR § 54.422 (low-income support); and  
9 D. 47 CFR § 54.1009 (mobility fund support).

10 b. Copies of the foregoing 2013 FCC reports shall be filed with  
11 Commission no later than fourteen (14) days after each report is due to be  
12 submitted to the FCC. Subsequent updates or revisions to such reports  
shall be filed no later than five business days following the date any  
update or revision is submitted to the FCC.

13 c. Each carrier receiving federal high-cost support shall, no later than July  
14 15, 2013, file a notarized affidavit from an officer of the carrier company  
15 in the form approved by Commission staff certifying that all federal high-  
16 cost support received within Oregon was used in the preceding calendar  
year, and will be used in the coming calendar year only for the provision,  
maintenance and upgrade of facilities and services for which the support is  
intended.

17 2. The Parties acknowledge that this Partial Stipulation pertains only to annual reporting  
18 requirements as initially set forth in Order 06-292; it does not relieve any carrier of  
19 any special reporting requirements adopted in any other Commission order, nor does  
20 it bar the inclusion of special reporting requirements for any carrier in any future  
21 Commission order.

22 3. The Parties acknowledge that when filing a report submitted to the FCC with the  
23 Commission, an ETC may submit a document or a portion of a document to the  
24 Commission under a claim of confidentiality pursuant to OAR 860-001-0070.  
25

- 1 4. The Parties agree that Staff may request clarification of annual reports for 2013 and  
2 request additional information related to re-certification of high-cost FUSF support  
3 under 47 CFR § 54.314.
- 4 5. The Parties agree that this Partial Stipulation does not alter or limit the reporting  
5 obligations of any carrier subject to the current reporting requirements in OAR  
6 Chapter 860, Division 33.
- 7 6. The Parties agree to re-visit, in this docket, this issue of the annual reports for ETC  
8 recertification after October 1, 2013, to consider whether the reporting requirements  
9 set forth in Order 06-292 should be modified for 2014 or any subsequent years.
- 10 7. The Partial Stipulation will be offered into the record of the above-captioned docket  
11 pursuant to OAR 860-001-0350. The Parties will support the Partial Stipulation  
12 throughout this proceeding and any appeal, provide witnesses to sponsor the  
13 Stipulation at any hearing held in the above-captioned docket, and recommend that  
14 the Commission issue an order adopting the settlement contained herein.
- 15 8. The Parties have negotiated the Partial Stipulation as an integrated document. If the  
16 Commission rejects all or any material portion of the Partial Stipulation, or conditions  
17 its approval upon the imposition of additional material conditions, any party  
18 disadvantaged by such action shall have the rights provided in OAR 860-001-0350  
19 and shall be entitled to seek reconsideration of the Commission's order.
- 20 9. By entering into this Partial Stipulation, no party shall be deemed to have approved,  
21 admitted or consented to the facts, principles, methods or theories employed by any  
22 other party in arriving at the terms of the Stipulation. No party shall be deemed to  
23 have agreed that any part of the Partial Stipulation is appropriate for resolving issues  
24 arising in any other proceeding.
- 25 10. The Partial Stipulation may be executed in counterparts and each signed counterpart  
26 shall constitute an original document.
